



Cardinal recently completed renovations to the Wellness Clinic for the Hanover Insurance Group. The renovation was performed while surrounding areas were occupied.

The adjacent corridor serves as the major access to Hanover's corporate dining area; therefore safety, dust control, noise infiltration and accessibility were major concerns for the client.

The scope of the project included demolition of concrete masonry unit (CMU) walls and other wall types. The construction was performed under a fast-track schedule to meet the requirements of the client. The previous Wellness Clinic

was not compliant with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), and the scope of the work included bringing this program space into full compliance while improving the interior aesthetics and offerings within the space. Aesthetic improvements included new radius walls, lighting, security doors, and upgraded finishes.
